OPINION N^{ER} 08-CIDESD-2011

In accordance with the ethical principles of the World Medical Association's Declaration of Helsinki, in what concerns research involving human subjects, the Ethics Committee of the Research Centre in Sports and Human Development (CIDESD) issues the following opinion:

a) The project "Physical activity in adults and older adults measured by accelerometry - Influence of age group, gender, period of the year, and weather conditions" under the orientation of Professor Paula Mota, complies with all ethical aspects established in the Helsinki Declaration¹, which were recently described by Harris and Atkinson (2009)².
